

I thoroughly enjoy! 65 **TR5 Trophy** 500 Pre 1950 1949 Triumph VMCC (Surrey & Sussex) Club: Bike Details: Based on the Speed Twin, 1949 was the first year of production for the TR5 trials machine. The name came from the three specials that Triumph built for the 1948 Italian ISDT, which won 3 gold medals & a team trophy. The original TR5 models of 1949 used the aluminium cylinder barrels & heads from a generator motor Triumph supplied to the WD in WW2. This was Triumph's first aluminium cylinder head/barrel, and factory employees speculated that the alloy heads, with their superior cooling properties, could easily be adapted for a motorcycle. I bought this bike 30 years ago with many faults & incorrect parts. It took me around 5 years to complete a nut & bolt rebuild to the standard you see today; a genuine square barrel TR5, ridden and not just shown. It was a finalist in the 2014 Classic Bike magazine Bike of The Year competition, not bad for a garden-shed restoration! 98 **International Model 30** 1950-59 1949/5Norton 500 Club: Norton OC (Kent) Bike Details: This is an International Special. 1949 Norton 30M (Manx) 499cc all-alloy engine with 9 to 1 piston, fitted with a 1948 Manx head/barrel into a 1954 bolt up Inter frame from Reg Dearden. It then had various owners until I purchased the bike in a very sorry state as it had been stored in a very damp shed. The frame, forks and swinging arm have been stripped down with bearings and seals replaced. I have just completed a top end engine rebuild. Replacing all new valve guides, both exhaust valves, valve springs, new piston rings and a light hone of the bores. 67 **Thunderbird** 650 1950-59 1958 Triumph Club: Bike Details: Purchased about six years ago, and brought up to current condition by the owner, with help from Dave Degens. 55 **Gold Star DBD34** 500 1950-59 1959 BSA Club: Roaring Twenties MCC Bike Details: First registered on the 2nd October 1959. 44 197 1950-59 1959 Francis-Barnett Falcon 81 Club: Francis-Barnett Owners Club Bike Details: The original cost of this bike in 1959 with tax was £159-13 shillings & 7 pence. A stop light switch was an extra 16/6. Made in Coventry, production ceased in the early '60s. Hardly regarded as a 'classic' these days, it was a very popular utility (ride to work) bike at the time, and with Villiers engines and solid frames there are plenty of these strong and reliable bikes still around. They were also popular on the Trials scene. A vibrant and helpful owners club, coupled with Villiers engine spares still being available ensures these strong & reliable bikes will be around a lot longer. I have owned this bike for about 25 years but until the Covid lockdown it was untouched at the back of the garage. With the boredom of lockdown I started renovating it. With help & advice from various people at the FBOC and the DVLA in getting an age-related number, it was back on the road. Initially I paid £300 for it & spent lots more on missing parts & spraying. It looks pretty good now & has rekindled my love of motor bikes, gave me a purpose in lockdown & rejuvenated my mechanical skills. 66 G₃C 1950-59 Competition / Special 1959 Matchless 350 AJS & Matchless OC (Susse Club: Bike Details: This bike was fitted with a 1962 short-stroke motor some years ago by the previous owner as a Matchless version of Gordon Jackson's famous "1 dab" ISDT AJS, registration 187 BLF. Ridden here today, about 60 mile round trip. Quite slow but great fun. Unused for 17 years before purchase earlier in the year. After fitting new tyres, changing the oil and giving it a good clean it started straight away and I've not touched it since. A UK registered bike and only 50 imported. I'm not sure how many still exist. 105 1960-69 1960 Norton **Dominator 99 De Luxe** 600 Club: Norton OC (Surrey) **Featherbed** Bike Details: Rebuilt from a wrecked basket case 30 years ago using mostly old parts it has been in continuous use since then . With the current owner for some 30 years, with one previous owner. This bike spent the first 10 years being ridden all over Europe as a press photographer's transport to Grand Prix events. It was written off in a crash in 1970 and was left dismantled for many years until I found the current owner rebuilt it in 1990. It was rebuilt using all original parts except the body panels, which came from another bike. Originally fitted with alloy panniers and fairshield engine enclosures, it is now fitted with Craven panniers. The engine has lightened 650 pistons fitted, with 10 thou OS bores otherwise all original. Always in use, it starts first kick, idles slow and quiet, very economical and fast. 
